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How to Measure a Room:

- ✓ To begin, draw an outline of the room
- ✓ Measure and record the ceiling height
- ✓ Measure and record all wall lengths
- ✓ Measure and record the size and location of doors and windows, recording their height and width from **outside edge to outside edge** of frame.
- ✓ Identify and note existing plumbing, electrical and lighting on all walls
- ✓ Record measurements and placement of any appliances
- ✓ Note locations of ventilation and duct-work on your drawing

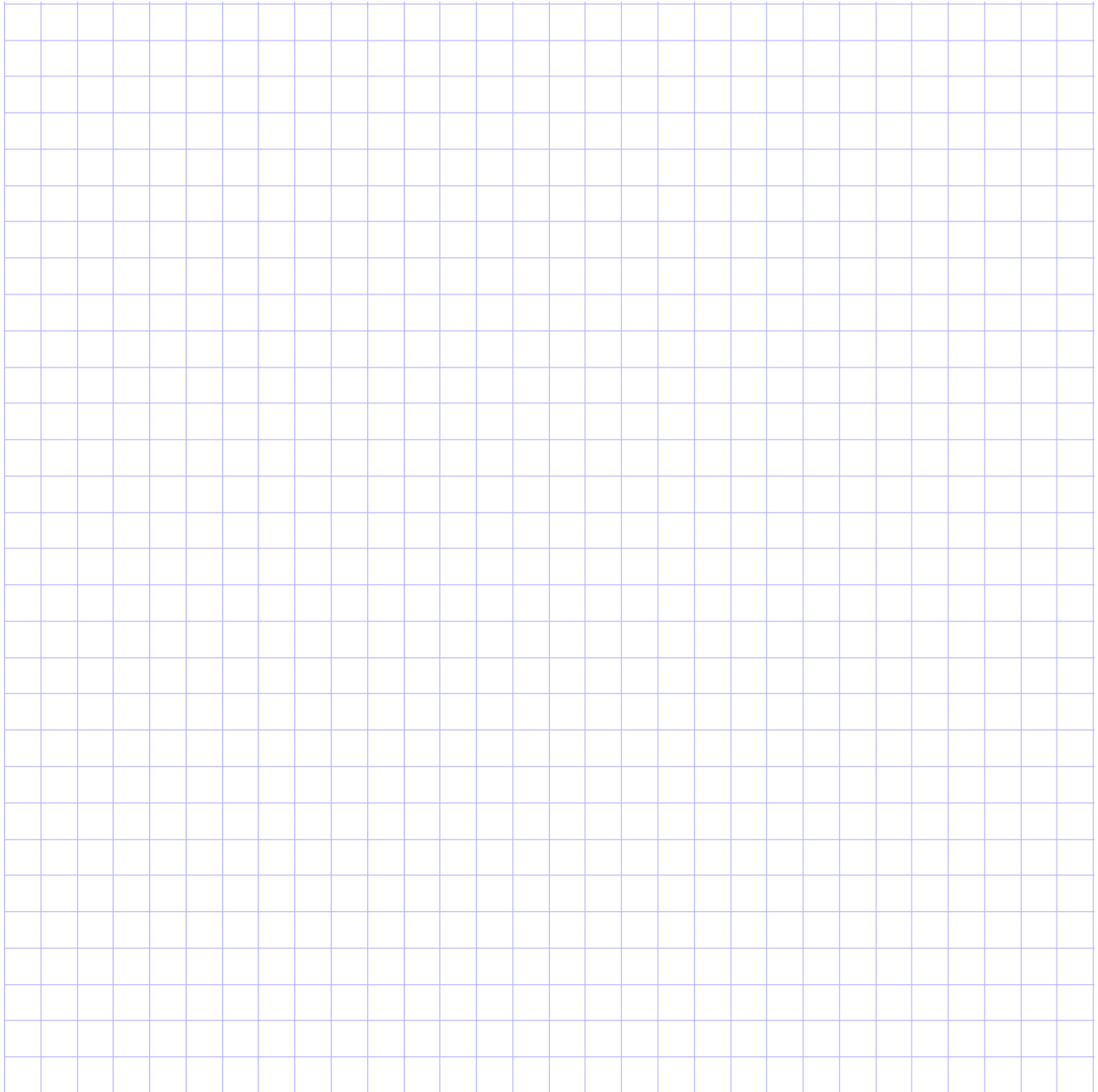
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
